Dear Parent/Carer,

This half term our topic is called 'Bright Lights, Big City'. We will be learning all about the United Kingdom and the Royal Family. This booklet is to inform you of what your child will be learning this term in the Squirrel and Fox classes.

<u>Mathematics</u>

In maths we will be looking at the position of numbers on a number line. We will be continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s and be solving practical addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems. We will be reinforcing the quick recall of addition facts up to 10.

English

In English we will be reading the fantastic books 'The Queen's Hat' and 'The Queen's Handbag' by Steve Antony. We will be retelling the story and writing our own versions. We will be concentrating on sentence writing skills ensuring we use capital letters and full stops. The children will use their phonic knowledge and apply it to their spelling and know how to use conjunctions to add more detail to their sentences.

Topic (Geography)

We will be learning about how to use geographical skills such as reading maps, recognising some features on aerial photographs and drawing our own symbols for places on maps (such as churches, schools and shops).

Art & DT

In art we will know how to hatch and stipple. We will then use these art skills to create a London cityscape. In Design and Technology we will be learning about different types of bread and where it comes from. We will finish this topic by making our own bread rolls.

<u>I CT</u>

In ICT we will be learning about good and bad experiences online and how to stay safe on the internet.

<u>Science</u>

In science we will be learning about properties of materials and will compare objects, using the terms 'hard' or 'soft', for example. We will also be findings ways of testing how flexible particular materials can be.
