At Park Lane School we unlock potential by:

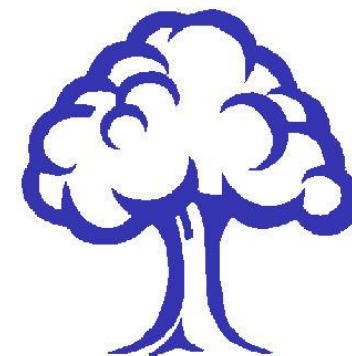
- Having the **COURAGE** to try things out and persevere when meeting new experiences
